THE FA SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN FOOTBALL WORKSHOP

For everyone who works with young people, this workshop focuses on making football safe. The course teaches our football workforce to promote best practice to protect young people. Candidates will learn how to recognise signs and symptoms of abuse, and understand fears involved in these concerns.

The workshop will raise awareness and specifically help candidates to be able to:

- Identify and build on best practice in football
- Recognise signs of abuse and identify what behaviour causes concern
- Identify the actions to take if you have a concern and who can help
- Develop your action plan for change

Indoor area with adequate seating and tables for group work on this workshop for all candidates on the course. Access to electrical points for IT equipment is essential.

LAWS OF THE GAME WORKSHOP

This workshop is to upskill volunteers who step in to referee games in the absence of a qualified referee. This workshop details the Laws of the Game that are applicable to refereeing a game of football to a satisfactory level. It will cover the powers and duties of the referee, number of players and their equipment, offside, fouls and misconduct and all the necessary Laws on how to restart the game after all stoppages. A short question paper can be incorporated; upon completion a certificate will be received.

ASSISTANT REFEREE WORKSHOP

This workshop is aimed to upskill volunteers when assisting the referees on a match day, it will cover the following;

- Correct flag techniques
- The best viewing positioning required to give accurate signals
- Laws of the Game that an assistant referee would need to know

The overall outcome of the workshop is to ensure individuals gain a better understanding of the assistant referee role.

Remember: Coach Education sessions are delivered centrally via Norfolk FA and all coaches can attend at no cost, however, if the need is there for further coach development please utilise this opportunity.

Facility Requirements:	Access to a pitch (minimum size, 7aside) and an indoor area with adequate seating and tables for group work for all candidates on the course. Access to electrical points for IT equipment is essential.

ENGAGING THE NEXT GENERATION WORKSHOP

Need help engaging young people to get involved in volunteering within football in either a coach or referee capacity, this workshop will look to challenge the group's leadership and give them an introduction to coaching and refereeing. It will also provide a snapshot of what young people can expect if they were to get involved in the Norfolk FA Football Futures programme.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ORGANISING THESE WORKSHOPS?

FA Charter Standard Clubs are responsible for organising the entire workshop, booking the venue and liaising with Norfolk FA for tutor availability and ensuring the participant requirements are met.

WHAT VENUE CAN WE USE?

Any local venue can be used, for example it could be at an FDC, a school, a local pavilion or a social club. The Club organising the workshop must book the venue and ensure it meets the facility requirements detailed.

WHAT IF WE DON'T HAVE ENOUGH PARTICIPANTS?

Allow time to advertise these to your target audience. To make sure you meet the participant requirements promote and open it to other local Clubs and/or Leagues.

CAN WE PUT A PARTICIPANT COST ON THE WORKSHOP WE ORGANISE?

Yes, nothing is stopping a Club charging participants to attend.

HOW DO WE PAY FOR THESE WORKSHOPS?

Once the workshop has been delivered, Norfolk County FA will invoice the Club for payment.

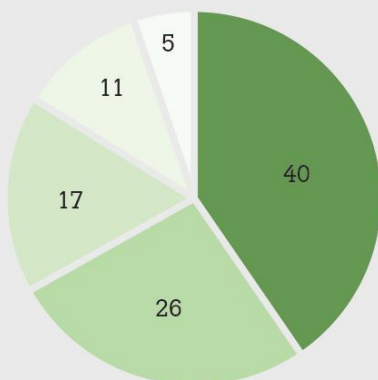
Norwich play parks became voluntary smoke-free zones in August 2016. Parks in Breckland and Broadland have also adopted the concept.
