WELCOME

Welcome to the latest edition of the Norfolk County FA bulletin. This communication is the third of the 20/21 season and, as we once again face a period without football, we will aim to update you as best we can during this second lockdown period.

STATEMENT FROM THE FA ON NON-ELITE FOOTBALL

The Football Association [The FA] can provide clarification for 'non-elite' football in England – including school, further and higher education football activities – on the UK Government's new national Covid-19 restrictions that are now in place until Wednesday 2 December 2020.



As a result of the UK Government's new national Covid-19 restrictions, which have been voted in favour of by Members of Parliament, The FA can confirm that the following aspects of 'non-elite' football in England are to be suspended during this period:

- All fixtures and training for Steps 3-6 of the National League System [NLS];
- All fixtures and training for Tiers 3-7 of the Women's Football Pyramid [WFP];
- All fixtures and training for the Regional NLS Feeder Leagues;
- All fixtures and training for the Barclays FA WSL Academy League [see below];
- All fixtures and training for FA Girls Regional Talent Clubs;
 All fixtures and training for indoor and outdoor youth and adult grassroots football.

LOCKDOWN 2 AND THE IMPACT ON NORFOLK FOOTBALL

The new restrictions associated with this second lockdown will also have a wider impact on Norfolk FA and our Football Development Facilities.

We can confirm that our FDC facilities ceased operations from close of play on 4 November onwards.

This will see a postponement of bookings, season tickets and County 5IVES fixtures for what we envisage to be a four week 'pause' to the football season, up until Wednesday 2 December.

NCFA Staffing

Regrettably, the financial impact that this second lockdown period will undoubtedly have on us as an Association has resulted in us having to once again operate on reduced staffing levels as we utilise the Government's job retention scheme.

More specific information regarding furloughed staff and points of contact over the next four weeks will be made available in due course.

As we enter a second lockdown period, our Club & League Support WebEx will return to ensure all clubs and leagues are provided with key information during this time.




The WebEx will be running from 6.30pm – 8.00pm on Thursday 12th November 2020.
