





MEN'S HEALTH WELLBEING GROUP

Men from across Norfolk will be given 'All to Play For' while also looking after their mental health by joining a new football group designed to help improve their physical and emotional wellbeing.



The free sessions are being run at the Football Development Centre, Bowthorpe by Norfolk and Suffolk NHS Foundation Trust (NSFT) in partnership with Active Norfolk, and are open to all adult men – both in and out of services – who feel they need extra support with their wellbeing.

The sessions will take place at The FDC for 10 to 12 weeks, beginning on Wednesday, September 27 at 1pm.
