Player Registrations 2021-2022

- For the 2022-2023 season all clubs within Norfolk sanctioned leagues will complete player registrations online via the new Club Portal.
- The registration window opens on 4th July for all leagues.
- All 2021-2022 player registrations expired on 30th June and as such are now free agents.



Overview

- All player registrations must be submitted in the new Club Portal
- Offline Consent forms are not to be sent into the County FA, but instead must be retained by the club
- Player registrations will still be shown in fulltime
- "Consent" from the player/parent or guardian is still required either online or offline



Online Consent

- Online consent in the club portal now lasts for up to 5 seasons This doesn't mean they have to register for 5 seasons.
- Up to date player registration information must still be obtained and the email address listed on the FAN must be a valid email address.
- This replaces the need for a signed consent form.
- For youth records it requires a parent/guardian record (which includes a valid email address) to be attached to the child's FAN. To do this the date of birth for the parent / guardian is required.



Offline Consent

- An offline "consent" form will need to be completed these are available on our website.
- Make sure you store the forms in a safe place and inline with your clubs privacy policy.
- Ensure you have this completed prior to completing the process on The Club Portal.



A Reminder on GDPR

- When collecting personal data from anyone you must show your club's privacy policy
- Club privacy policy templates are available on the registrations page of our website.
- A review of your club player records is required ahead of the registration process.








Transfer Process


- Notice of approach to current team

- Submit the registration as normal on the Club Portal




De-Registrations (Youth Only)













Match Day Registrations

 Registrations must be completed and submitted on the new Club Portal prior to kick- off

OR

 Match day registration forms to be countersigned by the opposition and then submitted via the new Club Portal on the same day.



Transfer Notice of Approach Process

- Process remains the same as last season i.e. offline
- If the system flags a notice of approach you will need to put in a 7 day notice via email / letter to the club(s) that the club portal flags.
- If a notice of approach is flagged stop at this point, do not continue with this registration, until the notice of approach has been served or waived.



Transfer Notice of Approach Process

A notice of approach will generate for the following reasons:

- Same League
- Same Day of Play
- If a club has another team with the same day of play
