About the Norfolk FA Youth Council:

The Norfolk FA Youth Council was formed in January 2017 and is now about to enter its sixth football season. The Youth Council has been involved with events such as Norfolk FA County Cup Finals, volunteer awards evenings, festivals of football and our own leadership events. The Council is all about giving young people a voice to impact the game in Norfolk; by providing a platform of opportunity.

The 2021-2022 Youth Council will provide an opportunity for its members to develop and exercise their leadership skills in new environments, whilst building on their legacy to inspire and invoke positive change within Norfolk Football.

Essential Criteria:

- Aged between 16 25
- Actively involved with Norfolk Football
- Live in Norfolk
- Must be fully committed to using this experience to develop yourself and others
- Must have or commit to obtaining an FA Criminal Records Check (CRC)

Requirements of a Youth Council Member:

- Available to attend the 2021-22 induction training event (Date: TBC)
- Available to commit to attending Youth Council Meetings (6 across the season) online & face to face
- Engaging on the Youth Council's networking platform (Microsoft Teams)
- Completing assigned targets relating the ongoing projects
- Nominate and reward young people for the excellent work happening within Norfolk Football
- Attend or support a minimum number of three Norfolk FA events
- Adhere to Norfolk FA Youth Council terms of reference and Code of Conduct

Youth Council Roles

Chairperson – responsible for organising and directing meetings of the Youth Council. They will support the other Youth Council members in achieving their own individual set targets which support the annual strategy.

Vice Chairperson – stands in for the Chairperson and helps with difficult decisions between meetings. Should liaise regularly with the Chairperson and ensure they know enough about current projects to be able to stand in at short notice.

Inclusion Lead – leads on the inclusion work of the Youth Council and supports the Football Development Team with inclusion based work during the season, specifically in relation to young people. Represents the Youth Council on the Inclusion Strategy Advisory group.

Marketing Lead – leads on all marketing work for the Youth Council including social media content, capturing information from young people in football, tracking trends, event promotion, and liaising with the Norfolk FA Marketing Team where necessary.

Youth Council Member – contributes to the Youth Council's Operational Plan, completes assigned actions relating to ongoing projects, represents the views of young people in football, and supports the Inclusion and Marketing Leads where necessary.

Norfolk FA Youth Council members will be expected to understand and work in accordance with the values and behaviours described below.
