What entry requirements do I need to join this course?

96 UCAS points (on the new framework equivalent to MMM) or relevant industry experience. We require that all applicants must have at least a C in GCSE English and Maths or a Functional Skill equivalent.

How will I be assessed during the course?

Assessments have been designed to give you the opportunity to develop skills, experience and the critical thinking needed to excel within the Football Industry. Written reports, presentations, reflective journals, research projects, practical assessments and work placements and lab will be used to assess your progress as well as recording your impact whilst on a work placement.





What are the course fees?

The course fees are £8,000 per year. The BA Hons Degree is a 3 year programme

How much will I have to study each week?

The programme is a blended learning format for approximately 14 hours per week; consisting of face to face lectures (Wednesday & Thursday) and online learning (Friday). In a addition there will be 80 hours of work placements in year two; working with local employers within the football industry. Additional reading and completing assessments outside of this is required in order to be successful on the course.
