




North Riding County FA's role within the Grass Pitch Programme is to strategically deliver natural grass pitch improvements across the North Riding of Yorkshire.

By 2024, collectively we need to ensure that there are 146 grass pitches that are at a 'GOOD' or better quality.

PITCHPOWER

PitchPower is a web app that puts the power in your hands, making it easy to sign up and carry out pitch inspections. You'll then get a detailed assessment report from the grounds management experts at the GMA with recommendations on improving the quality of your grass pitches.

- + Allows you to self-assess your pitches, and record, store and update information yourself
- Significantly reduces the time it takes to receive the report compared with site visits
- + Provides seasonal, ongoing advice about how to improve your pitch
- Works via a combination of photographs (site condition and soil sample) and information input
- Free to download and use User guide, instructional videos on the Football Foundation website
- Please ensure you use PitchPower on all your pitches if you want to apply for funding







If applying for Football Foundation grants, you will need to submit 2 yearly inspections within the following windows:

JUL - OCT

NOV - MAR

APR - JUN

GRASS PITCH MAINTENANCE FUND



The Grass Pitch Maintenance Fund is a six year tapered grant, providing up to £2500 inc. VAT for every one of your 11 a side pitches in the first two years and scaled down over six years (£2,000 for 9 a side and £1,500 for Mini Soccer)

Your PitchPower pitch inspection will provide you with a Performance Quality Standard (PQS) per pitch. This will decide how much funding you'll be eligible for, as well as providing a list of maintenance recommendations which you'll need to carry out as part of your grant award. Grants are paid annually for six years but tapered down during that time. The amounts shown are the grant values for the first year at 100% funding.

What can the grant be spent on?

The funding provided must be used to carry out the recommendations from your PitchPower Assessment Report

These can include:

- + Contractor works e.g. slitting, scarification or decompaction
- + Purchasing materials e.g. seed or fertiliser
- + Purchasing equipment e.g. Soil Sampler

For pitches with a PQS of 'Basic' or below.

11v11 £2,500
9v9 £2,000
MINI SOCCER £1,500
SUSTAIN

For pitches with a PQS of 'Good' or higher.

11v11 £750 9v9 £500 MINI SOCCER £300

Tapered means that we'll pay a reduced percentage of the initial grant value every two years with the club making up the difference. More details can be found on the FAQs.

SMALL GRANTS

Grants of up to £25,000 to help clubs and organisations purchase machinery and equipment recommended in their PitchPower assessment report. Machinery and equipment may be new or used and all applicants will be required to supply two like-for-like quotations for each item from different suppliers and evidence of partnership funding (grants will be provided for a maximum of 75% of the project cost).

What else can the grant be spent on?

- + Grass Pitch Drainage
- Changing Pavilion/Clubhouse Refurbishments
- Fencing
- + Goalposts
- Portable Floodlights
- Storage Containers
- + 3G Pitch Machinery & Equipment
