

ENGLAND NOTTINGHAMSHIRE FA FOOTBALL CARDS, SIN BINS AND ACCUMULATIONS

Throughout a season, players may receive cards in a few ways (yellow cards, sin bins or red cards). Red cards carry with them an automatic suspension, which will activate 7 days after they are shown. An overview of red card suspensions can be found below:

Red Card Type	Suspension Length	
S1 (Serious Foul Play)	3 Matches	
S2 (Violent Conduct)	3 Matches	
S3 (Spits at an Opponent or any Other Person)	6 Matches	
S4 (Denying an Obvious Goalscoring Opportunity - Handball)	1 Match	
S5 (Denying an Obvious Goalscoring Opportunity by Foul)	2 Matches	
S6 (Using Offensive, Insulting or Abusive Language/Behaviour)	2 Matches	
S7 (Receives a Second Yellow Card in the Same Match)	1 Match	

The length of suspension for repeat offenders in the same season may differ from the above table of guidance. An overview of yellow card accumulation suspensions can be found below:
