Kidlington FC were founded in 1909 and played local village football, rivalry was so keen that players had to prove they were residents of the village for whom they played. In 1945, Kidlington moved from village football to play in the Oxford City Junior League, with a good deal of success in both league and cup. By 1951 the Oxfordshire Senior League was entered, where stronger competition was provided by the likes of Witney Town; Morris Motors; Pressed Steel and Thame United. In the 2006/07 season the Reserves won Reserve Division One for the first time, they won it again in the 2007/08 season. The Reserves now play in the Hellenic League and are looking for even more success.

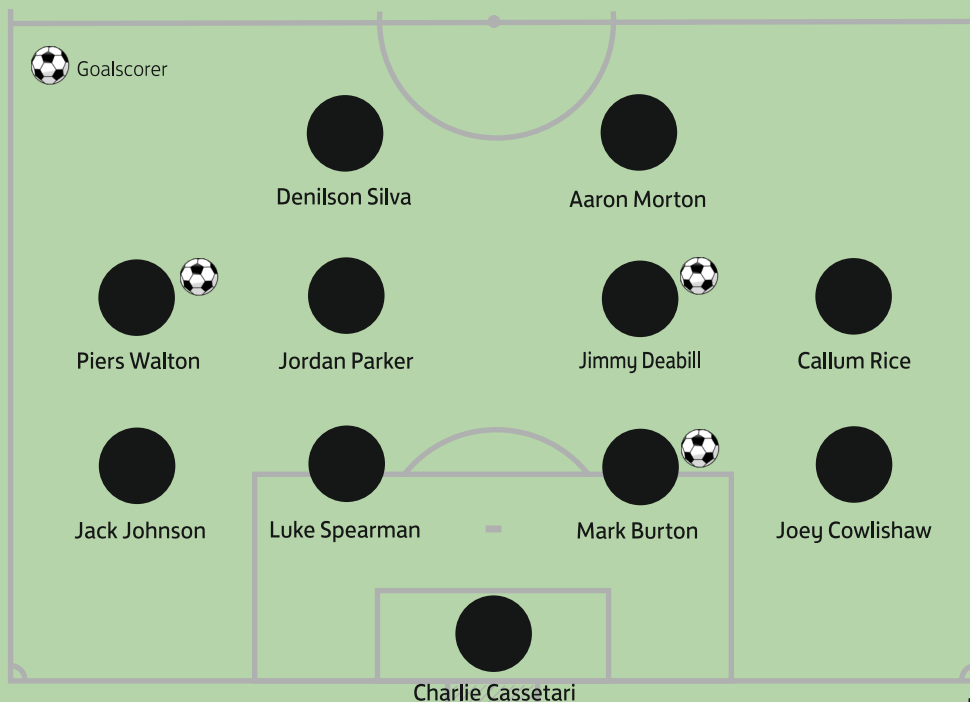

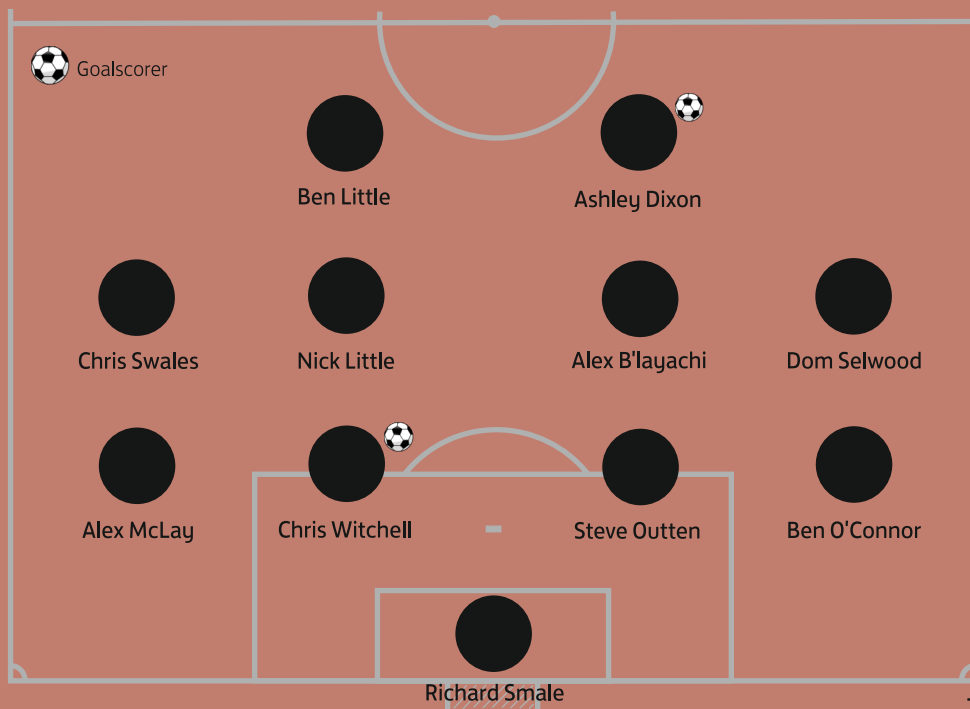

If the scores are level at the end of the normal time (45 minutes each way) then extra-time will be played (15 minutes each way). If the scores are still level at the end of extra-time then a penalty shootout will take place until a winner has been determined.
