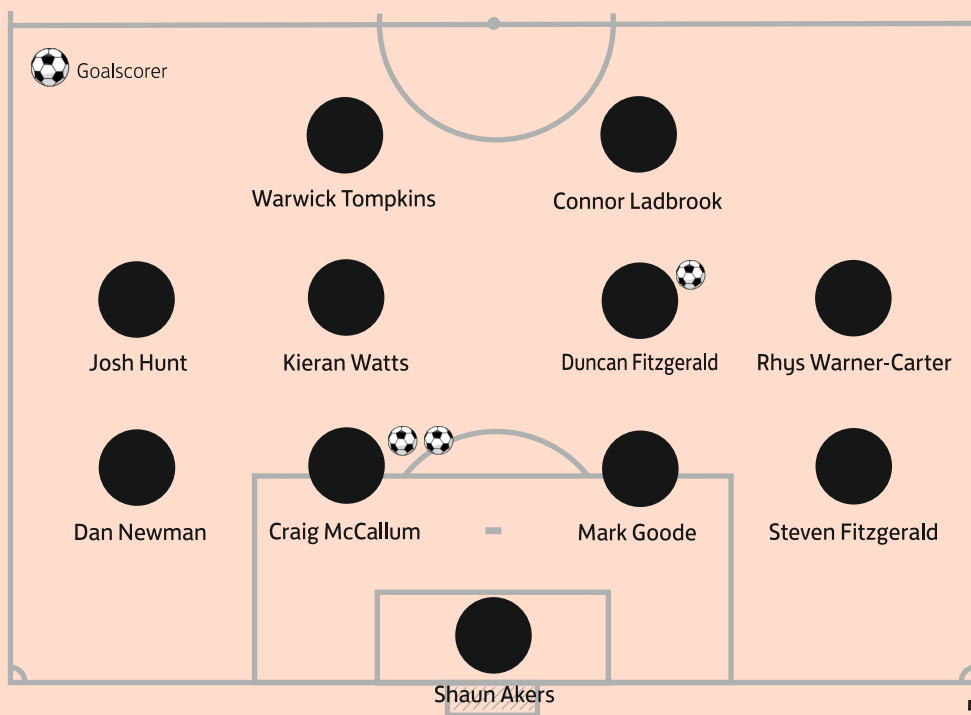

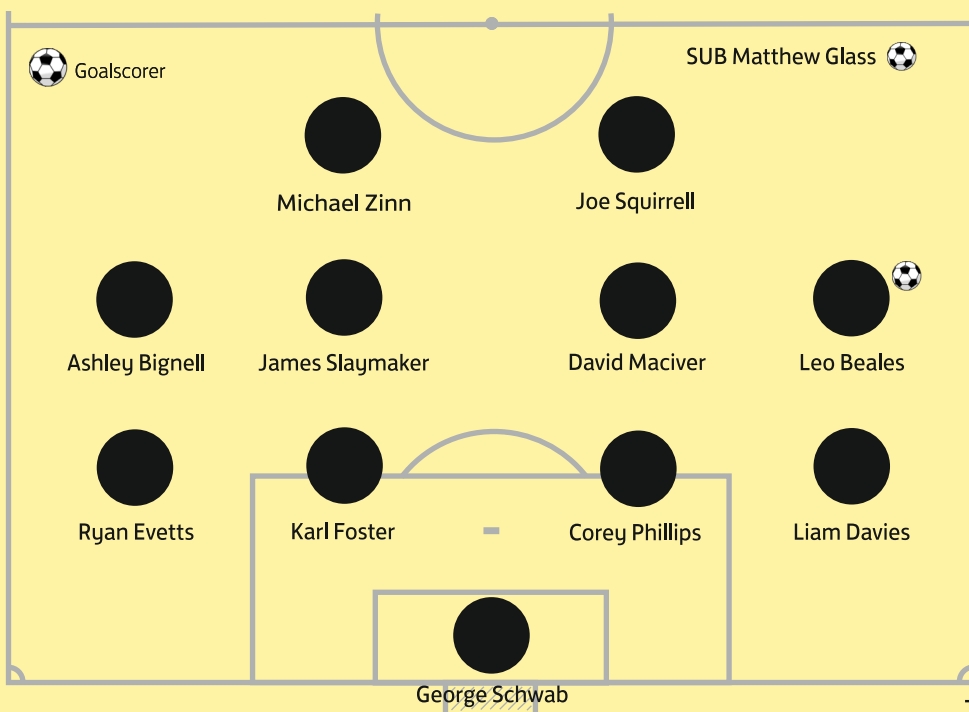

MATCH REFEREE - David EVANS

He first started refereeing in 1993 whilst at University in Nottingham. He re-qualified as a referee in 2013 and started to climb the refereeing ladder from then. He has been involved in some interesting games during his career including in the FA Cup, Women's FA Cup, Reading Senior Cup and Oxfordshire FA County Cups. In 2017 he was lucky enough to be selected to be Assistant Referee on the Oxfordshire FA Junior Shield final.



ASSISTANT REFEREE - Andrew HUNT

This is Andrews fourth season refereeing, and he is currently a level 5 promotion candidate. His refereeing highlight so far is being an assistant referee at Wembley for the Youtubers Wembley Cup in 2018.



ASSISTANT REFEREE - Adrian GARRARD

Adrian is a level 5 referee and has been refereeing since 2004, including youth football with the Witney and District Youth League and men's football with the Banbury District and Lord Jersey FA. Adrian's highlights include officiating at Coronation Cup, Jersey Cup and Charity Cup Finals as well as running the line in earlier rounds of the FA Cup.



FOURTH OFFICIAL - Ireneos CHRISTODOULOU

Ireneos started refereeing at the age of 14 and has been officiating now for over 13 years. His highlights so far include refereeing the OFA U16 Youth Cup final, lining the OFA Charity Cup final, lining Oxford City vs Hampton & Richmond in the National League South, lining Melksham Town vs Tring Athletic in the 5th round of the FA vase and lining Merthyr vs Swindon Supermarine in Wales.
