Steve, who came from Kidlington, was involved in youth football in the County for well over 30 years. His involvement included Kidlington Youth FC, a Council member and Director of the Oxfordshire FA. But more so for being general secretary of the Oxford Mail Youth Football League a position he held for more than 20 years.

Steve was always approachable and would help anyone who asked for his advice. He knew virtually all the answers, and when he didn't he would find out the answer and explain where necessary. This was particularly welcomed by many club

volunteers when trying to understand the maze of FA rules and regulations.

Steve initially got involved when his son joined the village side in Kidlington; first by helping out the manager, then becoming a manager of a boys team and then the very first girls team. He eventually became secretary for the club. In 1995 he joined the Oxford Mail Boys League, as it was then, and it was not long before he became secretary there too. The league grew and as rules changed to allow mixed football changed its name to the Oxford Mail Youth League reflect its more inclusive nature.

Steve and Mary, his wife, worked hard behind the scenes for all those children who played football every weekend. Not for the limelight, but to support the local community and enable thousands to enjoy playing organised football in a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment.

Steve, and Mary, "retired" from the game in 2017, which gave them more time to spend with their young granddaughter. It took them both a while to get used to the peace and quiet as the phone didn't ring nearly so often! But they still kept a watchful eye on the football community, from the "stands", through friendships they had formed over the many years.


OXFORDSHIRE FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT

He spent much of his life dedicating his time to local football in Oxfordshire, in particular youth football and, up until 2017, was Competition Secretary for the Women's, Girls Youth U16 & U14 and Youth U14 & U13 Cups. He was also General Secretary of the Oxford Mail Youth League for many years. The U14 Youth Cup first took place in 2003 and was won by Oxford Blackbird Boys. Oxford City have won the competition the most amount of times, winning it on three different occasions.

38 teams entered this year's competition and 225 goals have been scored so far.
