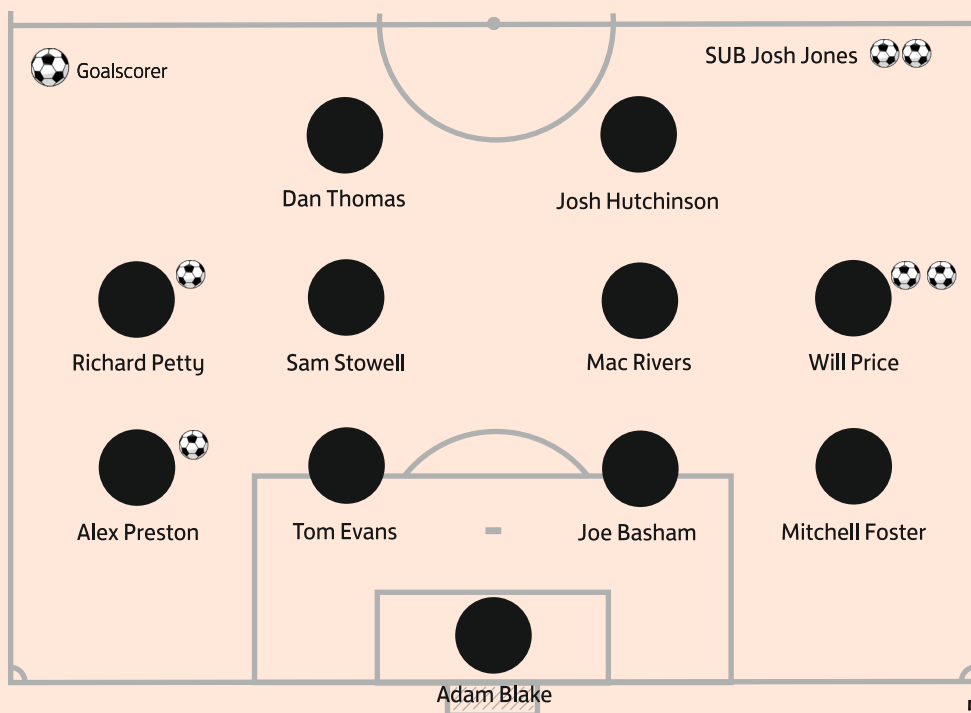

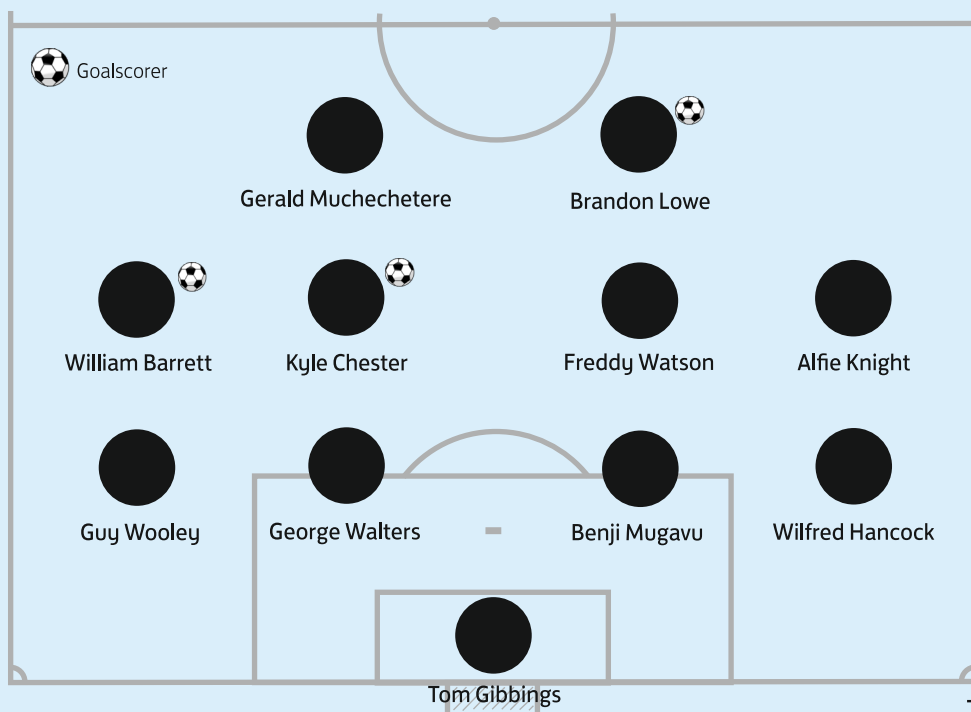

## **MATCH REFEREE - Andrew NESBITT**

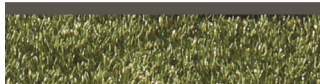
