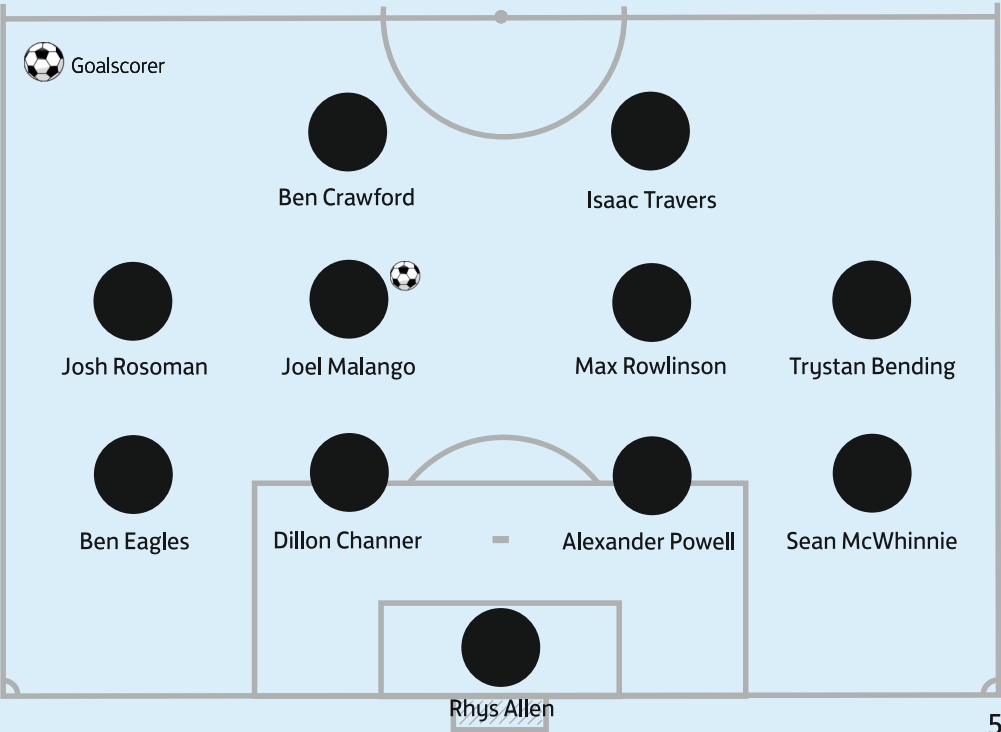

Clanfield (85) U16 were formally the North Leigh team that played in the Witney and District league, before joining the Oxford Mail league and are current holders of the U15 Oxfordshire County Cup. The current coaching team of Stewart Savin and Alan Heritage took over for the 2016/2017 season and saw the potential in a team that had already achieved some success. Since taking over, the team have become strong competitors in league and cup competitions. To achieve their full potential, for the start of this season the team moved to Clanfield to play as Clanfield (85) U16, where Stewart and Alan were also managing the U18 team with some success. That team won the U18 County Cup last season and reached the 2nd round of the FA Youth Cup, the only team not part of the top four English divisions to reach that round. The aim is for this team next season to play in the Allied Counties Youth League, and to introduce the boys to adult football with the Clanfield (85) Development team playing in the Hellenic League. At the time of writing the team are still in the running to win the Oxford Mail A League.

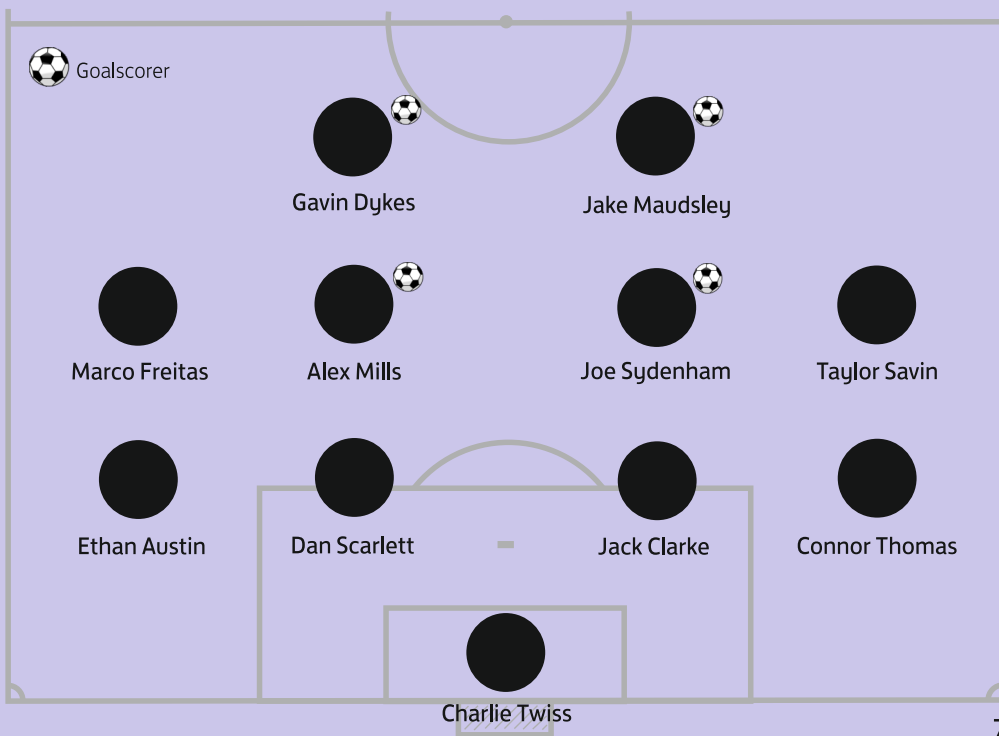

He qualified as a referee in January 2017 and officiated on the Witney and District League. He has since moved onto the North Berks Football League and the Hellenic League. He is very proud to finish this season having gained a promotion and being appointed as an official on an Oxfordshire FA Cup Final.



ASSISTANT REFEREE - Ioannis CHRISTODOULOU

His refereeing career began at the age of 14 when he was still playing football. He is now been refereeing for over 13 years and enjoys the profession. He has been a level 4 Supply League referee and contributory assistant referee for five seasons. He also mentors younger referees at the Oxford United Academy. The highlight of his refereeing career so far came when he was appointed to be the senior assistant referee on the Southern League Play-Off Final on May bank holiday in 2017.
