The Cup

The top 16 teams (1st and 2nd places from the leagues and the 4 best other teams) moved into the cup knock out stages, with the remaining 13 teams left to fight for the plate. This meant that there was still plenty of football to be played. Coningsby 'A' dispatched Brize Norton 'A' with a 6-0 victory and then beat their own 'B' Team 2-1 to move to the Cup semi-final. Leonardo would be their opposition after beating Linton-on-Ouse 5-0 and then Waddington Cat 3-1. In the other half of the draw things were far tighter with Wittering 'A' progressing to the semi-final following a 1-0 win over Marham and then a penalties victory over Waddington 'B' after drawing 1-1. They would play Waddington 'A' who eased past Swanwick 2-0 then then beat Lossiemouth 3-0.

In the semi-finals, Wittering beat Waddington 'A' and Leonardo beat Coningsby to secure the chance of glory. After a close final, the sponsor's team – Leonardo came out victors with a 2-1 victory.







The Plate

The Plate final was contested by Cosford 'B' and Boulmer. Cosford progressed to the final after a penalties victory over their 'A' team, another penalties victory against Spadeadam and then beating Digby.

Boulmer showed their potency in front of goal, after getting a bye in the first match, they won 3-0 against Benson 'A' then beat Brize Norton 3-0.

This free-scoring ability saw them come out clear victors after a 6-0 demolition of Cosford 'B' in the final.
