Typical Rep Team Organisation & Governance

The Director of Representative Teams (DRT) will preside over all RAF FA Rep Team Organisations and will be supported by The Chief of Staff (CoS). Each Rep Team will be typically led by a Team Manager (TM) and a General Manager (GM). The TM duties will routinely focus on supporting team performance and the GM duties will routinely focus on supporting team administration.

The GM will typically report directly to the DRT via CoS. Specialist support to each Rep Team will be provided via the Technical Director (TD) and Operations Director (OD) roles. The TD duties will routinely focus on the provision of additional technical support and the OD duties will routinely focus on the provision of additional administrative support. The DRT will preside over both TD and OD roles.


Each TM will typically preside over a Head Coach and several Senior and Rep Team Coaches and all coaches will be subject to internal and external performance reviews. The frequency of performance reviews should be annual for all coaches except the Team Manager who should be reviewed biannually. All coaches should be suitably qualified and experienced for their individual roles.

The RAF Head Scout (HS) will support all Rep Teams and duties will routinely focus on player recruitment. The TD will preside over the HS role.






Typical Rep Team Organisation







Typical Rep Team Coaching Qualifications


