### FAQs

#### 1. Do committee members need a FA DBS?

No, DBS checks are only required for anyone aged 16 years or over who undertakes any unsupervised roles with children and young people under the age of 18. See DBS guidance document.

**3. Do we require a Club Welfare Officer?** No, however if your club has players that are under 18 we would recommend this as best practice. In 2021-22 this will be mandatory for all adult clubs with U18 players.

4. Can I hold more than one role? Yes, however best practice is to have one person in each role.
