Lasting Power of Attorney

One person in the UK develops dementia every three minutes. Don't assume relatives can just walk into a bank and access your money, even if it is to pay for your care.

A lasting power of attorney is a legal document that allows a person to give another person authority to make a decision on their behalf. Unless you have a lasting power of attorney *already*, loved ones would need to apply to the Court of Protection which can be long and costly. *You can only set up a lasting power of attorney when you have mental capacity. Once you've lost capacity, it's too late.* So get it sorted – this session discusses how to do it.
