FOOTBALL IN STAFFORDSHIRE

Key areas of our work across grassroots football in Staffordshire include:

Coach Education & Development

- A comprehensive volunteer coach education & development programme.
- 100+ courses, 2,000+ attendees, 12 tutors, 9 coach mentors, regular CPD.
- Level 1, Level 2, UEFA B, Safeguarding, First Aid, Goalkeeping, Futsal, CPD.

County Cup Competitions & Finals

- Facilitating a high-quality county cup competition programme and finals.
- 13 competitions, 520 teams, 10,000+ players, 3,500 spectators at cup finals.
- Competitions from U15-adult, male & female, high profile senior cup finals.

Disability Football Participation Pathway

- Creating & developing playing opportunities for all players with disabilities.
- 310 players, 31 teams, 1 league, plus regular pathway events.
- Youth, Adult, Mental Wellbeing, Impairment Specific, Talent Hubs.

Female Football Participation Pathway

- Creating & developing playing opportunities for all female players.
- 2,840 players, 177 teams, 27 wildcats' centres, 4 leagues.
- Wildcats, Mini-Soccer, Youth, Adult, Mums, Vets, Walking Football, Futsal.

Male Football Participation Pathway

- Creating & developing playing opportunities for all male players.
- 30,031 players, 1,722 teams, 36 walking football centres, 20 leagues.
- Mini-Soccer, Youth, Adult, Vets, Walking Football, Flexible Football, Futsal.

Membership & Discipline

- Administering membership, insurance and discipline across the grassroots game.
- 519 clubs, 2,047 teams, 24 leagues, 8,926 discipline cases, 426 hearings.
- Membership, public liability insurance, personal accident insurance, discipline, hearings.

Pitch Improvement & Facility Development

- Investing heavily in clubs and volunteers to improve grassroots pitches and facilities.
- 1,022 pitches in Staffordshire, 2 local Pitch Advisors, 11 Local Football Facility Plans.
- Pitch Improvement Programme, Football Foundation investment, Local Authorities.

Referee Education & Development

- A comprehensive referee education & development programme.
- 949 registered referees, monthly courses, 8 tutors, regular CPD events.
- Mentoring programme, bespoke courses for ex-players, Respect initiatives.

Safeguarding & Welfare

- Ensuring a safe, enjoyable and inclusive environment across grassroots football.
- 345 Club WO's, 8 League WO's, 25 annual club visits, 18 Respect workshops.
- Safeguarding children and adults at risk, educating welfare officers, Respect initiatives.

Yarnfield Football Centre

- Staffordshire FA have recently taken on the running of this 9-pitch site.
- Home to 40 teams, mini-Soccer to adult, annual footfall of 60,000+.
- Stadium on site, excellent maintained pitches, great exposure opportunities.
