REOPENING YOUR 3G PITCH:

The main issues that your pitch may have suffered from during low/no use in lockdown are:

Surface debris -

Leaves, litter and other detritus.

Vegetation -

Weed & moss growth, particularly around the edges.

Infill compaction & displacement -

Winter rains and snowfall can both displace and compact the infill.

Failed seams, lines and spots -

Freezing temperatures can cause any weak joins to lift and fail.

So before reopening your pitch to users you should start with a full 'Health Check' inspection of its condition. If you have suitably trained and experienced staff, groundsman or volunteers then this could be done in-house. CHECKLIST:

- Inspect the pitch
- Check all seams, lines & spots
- Remove litter, leaves and debris
- Treat and remove weeds & moss
- Decompact, clean and redistribute the infill
- Top up high use areas (penalty spots, corners etc.)
- Check goalposts, nets, gates and fence
