



# Build, Sustain, Grow

*A kitemark for the Recreational Women's Game in Surrey*

## Build

- Minimum 1 person to have completed the FA Playmaker and/or an FA Coaching Qualification
- Minimum 1 person to have completed the FA Level 1 Introduction to First Aid in Football
- First Aid kit to be present at all sessions
- Where you have U18 players, a nominated person must obtain a DBS check
- Have a nominated key contact person for the group
- Use suitable & inclusive facilities; including female toilets, appropriate playing surface, accessible for all
- Have a code of conduct
- Evidence of good communications with members; e.g. WhatsApp group, Facebook group etc
- Have a method to gather player feedback
- Access to safeguarding support

## Sustain

- **Build** requirements above must be met
- Have an accessible Equality and Safeguarding policy in place
- Sign up for the Surrey FA "Technical Area" and "Clubhouse" newsletters to receive new opportunity updates
- Take part in the Surrey FA Flexi-League or a festival/tournament
- Team identity (such as a team name and logo) and colour (not necessarily full kit)

## Grow

- **Build & Sustain** requirements above must be met
- Must have a recognised lead coach
- Must have 1 person who has completed Mental Health Training
- Active social media
- Team kit i.e football kit or shirts with team identity/logo
- Review how to develop and sustain your sessions
- Provide regular competitive opportunities for members
- Player "Check-In" at least once per season
- Suitable CPD access for relevant coaches
- End of season gathering/awards
- Encourage players to complete FA Playmaker qualification
