The new affiliation model is here

CLUB AFFILIATION 2023/24

The Football Association (FA) have remodelled the Club Affiliation Process to provide a simpler, more consistent model for football clubs across England. These changes are effective from 5th June 2023. Affiliation is a national requirement for all football clubs. Clubs affiliate to their local County FA. Affiliation is an annual validation of your club, teams, and officials, ensuring everyone playing affiliated football is meeting a minimum set of requirements to ensure all participants are playing in a safe environment. To participate in a FA or County FA sanctioned league and/or competition your teams must be affiliated. MINIMUM SAFEGUARDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NEW SEASON

To affiliate, all Youth Teams Coaches (Lead and Assistant) must possess the Safeguarding Children Workshop Qualification. To assist coaches in meeting this requirement, The FA have reduced the cost of the course by 50% to £15 between 1st May -31st July 2023. Coaches can enrol on the course via England Football Learning Site.

To obtain the discount, follow these steps:

- Obtain a voucher code form your Club Welfare Officer
- Log into the site
- Click 'sign in to start the course'
- 4 Enter the voucher code
- Take the course
