Hearing Summary including Written Reasons

Disciplinary Commission Decision

Factual Background and Chronology

- 1. These are the Reasons for the decision of the Chairman.
- 2. The Commission member was Mr Stephen Daniels (Chairman).
- 3. The following is a summary or the principle submissions considered by the Chairman. It does not purport to contain reference to all the points considered, however the absence in these reasons of any particular point or submissions, should not imply that the Chairman did not take such point, or submission into consideration when the Chairman determined the matter. For all avoidance of doubt, the Chairman carefully considered all the evidence and materials furnished with regards to this case.
- 4. The charge in question arose in a game between Hornets First v Lower Teme & Martley Firsts on 20th December 2020. Following the fixture, a variety of reports were provided to the Worcestershire FA and details of this allegation were contained within these reports.
- By letter dated 23rd December 2020 James Todd was charged with FA Rule E3.1 Improper Conduct (Including foul and abusive Language) and FA Rule E3.2 Improper Conduct - aggravated by a persons Ethnic Origin, Colour, Race, Nationality, Faith, Gender, Sexual Orientation or Disability.
- 6. James Todd admitted the charge.

The Evidence

7. The Chairman had before him the following items of evidence:

 It was alleged that James Todd was charged with a breach of FA Rule E3.1 Improper Conduct (Including foul and abusive Language) and FA Rule E3.2 Improper Conduct

 aggravated by a persons Ethnic Origin, Colour, Race, Nationality, Faith, Gender, Sexual Orientation or Disability.

David Etheridge the match referee stated he gave a free kick against the player James Todd he took exception to my decision and called me a "fat mong" he went on to say "I don't care if you send me off you fat cunt, I will knock you out" As result of his actions I showed him the red card and sent him off. At that point James Todd the player pushed me aggressively in the chest causing me to lose my balance and fall backwards hitting my head on the ground as I fell. Following this assault on me I abandoned the match.

9. James Todd did not put in any mitigating circumstances.

Sanction

- 10. a. Six (6) Match ban
 - b. £75 fine
 - c. An online education course to be completed within 4 months
 - d. 6 penalty points
- 11. This decision may be appealed in accordance with the provisions in The FA Handbook.
