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





CLUB PATHWAYS RAISE STARS



ACCREDITED CLUBS RAISE STARS

England Football Accredited supports clubs to create more chances for more people to play football in approved leagues and competition.

More opportunities for male, female and disability players, from youth through to adult.

Whether you're a 1 star, 2 star or 3 star Accredited club that's ok because it takes a network of Accredited clubs to create more opportunities for players to be encouraged and supported on their journey.

All Accredited Clubs offer a consistent standard on- and off-pitch.

Stars are how England Football Accredited recognises you and the different support you need to grow your way, through the teams and pathways you offer.

What do the Accredited Player Pathways look like for 1star, 2star and 3star clubs?



To be a one star Accredited Club, you must:

Offer a minimum of one affiliated male or female or disability team at any age group playing within an FA sanctioned league competition.







To be a two star Accredited Club, you must:

Offer a complete accredited player pathway for either male or female or disability football, all playing within FA sanctioned League competitions.

In addition, offer a minimum of one team at any age group from an alternative pathway.

To be a three star Accredited Club, you must:

Offer the complete accredited player pathway for both male and female whilst offering a minimum of one disability team at any age group, all playing within FA sanctioned League competitions.

THE TRANSITION

FROM THE FA CHARTER STANDARD TO ENGLAND FOOTBALL ACCREDITED







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Clubs that are within 2 teams of meeting the 2star Accredited player pathways will be recognised as a 2star Accredited Club.* Clubs that are within 3 teams of meeting the 3star Accredited player pathways will be recognised as a 3star Accredited Club.*

*until at least November 2023



The timeline

November 2022 and Annually

Accredited clubs have from now until November 2022 to satisfy both on- and off-pitch criteria.

Accredited clubs will be validated against on- and off-pitch criteria November 2022 and then annually.

If you do not meet criteria, you will have a window of opportunity to add comment against any criteria not met for County FA approval.

Accredited clubs will have the teams you offer validated against the Accredited player pathway logic for the Accredited star you hold.*

If you do not meet the minimum number of teams for the Accredited player pathways for the star you are recognised for, the star will change.**

*2star and 3star clubs will be recognised as the star you have until November 2023. This is to give you the opportunity to develop the teams you have missing if it is within your club plans and ambitions.

**If by November 2023 you do not have the minimum number of teams to meet the Accredited player pathways for the star you currently have then your star will change.



CRITERIA FOR CLUBS

Clubs must be affiliated to their local CountyFA

Through affiliation Clubs will achieve the following Through the Clubs Portal, Clubs will achieve or evidence the following criteria: criteria:

Offer a minimum of one team at any age group for male or female or disability playing in an FA sanctioned competition.

Have an in-date FA Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service Checks (DBS) for all relevant officials.

Have a Welfare Officer for Youth Clubs (male, female and disability).

Safeguarding Committee Members course completed by Club committee members.

Evidence or adopt a set of Club rules and be a constituted Club.

Evidence or adopt the relevant Club safeguarding policies.

Evidence or adopt an equality policy.

Adopt the Football Leadership Diversity Code.

Adopt the Nationwide Respect codes of conduct and implement The FA Respect activations relevant to your club.

Have a bank account in the Club's name recommended for all Clubs and mandatory for Clubs with three or more teams.

Provide evidence of last season's accounts if in existence for more than one season.

Have a good disciplinary record within the Nationwide Respect disciplinary code (if in existence for more than one season).

Through the Club Portal, Clubs will continue to adhere to the criteria and complete the relevant validation process to remain England Football Accredited.

England Football Accredited Clubs will achieve on pitch and off pitch criteria:

On pitch

Adult teams should have a named individual that has completed the Introduction to First Aid in Football (IFAIF). If this person is a player, an additional person is required.

Youth teams to have at least one coach or manager with the Introduction to Coaching Football (I2CF) per team, with in date Introduction to First Aid in Football (IFAIF) and Safeguarding Children Course (SCC). A qualified coach or manager must be present at training and fixtures.

Have a coach:player ratio of 1:16 or less.

Off pitch

Complete the relevant Club development plan to support club development and sustainability.

Confirm Club meetings that take place and make sure they are recorded. Copies of minutes are available upon request.

Demonstrate that decisions made by the Club are informed by, and communicated to, it's members.

Processes

Teams with people that need access to achieve qualification criteria can find the courses here: www.thebootroom.thefa.com/learning and will show against their records in the Club Portal for validation each season.

Clubs will evidence official criteria through the Club Portal processes or through The County FA Development Officers.



CLUBS WORKING TOGETHER

CLUB PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Clubs that want to work in partnership with each other can do so by following and achieving the club partnership agreement.

To formalize the link you can do so within Club Portal by visiting 'LinkedOrganisations' under 'My Club'.

To demonstrate a partnership between two or more clubs please follow the club linking process available within the <u>Club Portal</u>. Clubs working in partnership should have in place a minimum of THREE from the seven recommendations below:

A formal partnership agreement signed between all linked clubs

Club constitution / rules amended to reflect partnership working between all linked clubs

A joint development and / or business plan to demonstrate and coordinate the ambitions of the partnership between all linked clubs

A joint vision to create more playing opportunities for male, female, and disability players within sanctioned competition between all linked clubs An agreed way of sharing resource, expertise, knowledge, and good practice between all linked clubs

Joint club meetings take place and are recorded between all linked clubs

Demonstrate that decisions made are informed by, and communicated to, all key officials, and where relevant club members, between all linked clubs.

There are two templates available for Accredited clubs, and depending on your size, you may want to utilise either the club season plan (recommended for 1star clubs) or the club development plan (recommended for 2star and 3star clubs).


League and Club Services

Accredited Clubs and the Club Portal

Become

Non-Accredited clubs can apply to become England Football Accredited within the Club Portal.

In order to apply they must meet the eligibility and minimum criteria, all of which can be evidenced within their club portal.

Renew

Existing England Football Accredited Clubs will renew every November, and annually, with the opportunity to see any gaps in your criteria 365 days of the year.

Your 'live' Accreditation Dashboard continuously shows where you are meeting both on-pitch and off-pitch criteria all year round.
