



HOW TO CREATE A MOMENT IN HISTORY FOR FOOTBALLREMEMBERS.COM

We want everyone who is playing football during Football Remembers Week to take a pre-match picture of their game and recreate the spirit of the Christmas Truce football matches of 1914. Photos will be uploaded via social media using the hashtag #FootballRemembers and appear on the www.FootballRemembers.com website. The aim of the website is to act as a moment of national record of football in 2014, a century on from the First World War. The 'Moment in History' photos will be preserved for future generations. Here is what to do to get involved:

Organise a football match

Any match of any size on any surface is eligible to appear on FootballRemembers.com. It could be a school or local league match, a five-a-side game or even a kickabout with your friends.

Take a pre-match photo

Assemble all the players together for a pre-match photo before kick-off. If it's a proper 11v11 or 9v9 or even 5v5 match then line up with the match officials before the coin-toss. The photo is meant to be informal with players from the two sides mixed together.

Upload your photo via Twitter or Instagram with #FootballRemembers

Using the hashtag #FootballRemembers, upload your photos via Twitter or Instagram. Accompany the picture with a simple, factual message of the match, venue, competition, date and the Football Remembers hashtag. For example, the picture below is: "Chelsea vs Liverpool, Christmas Truce National Tournament, Ypres, 16 November 2014 #FootballRemembers".



It can be from a group account e.g. your school or club, or a personal account, and multiple entries from the same social media account are permitted.

View it on FootballRemembers.com

Once you have uploaded your picture via social media then it should appear on the site. All photos (unless inappropriate, see the Terms & Conditions) should appear on the site. If you can't see yours then you can easily search for it. And that's it, your team will be part of a Moment in History.
