



FOOTBALLREMEMBERS.COM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Consent to publish photographs

By posting a photo you automatically submit authorisation of the persons in the photo. If the person in the photo is under 18 years of age, you thereby submit their parents' or carer's authorisation.

You confirm that the photo you tweet is your original work, is not defamatory and does not infringe any English laws, that you have the right to give the British Council permission to use it for the purposes set out in these terms and conditions, and that all necessary consents to tweet the photo have been obtained.

Internet safety

We advise that no one under 18 is full identified i.e. do not provide surnames.

Inappropriate content

The British Council and its partners may refuse to upload a posted photo to the website if it is deemed inappropriate. Definitions of inappropriate include false, offensive, sexually explicit, defamatory, threatening, obscene or unlawful content or content which infringes intellectual property rights.

Removal of content

General users of social media can remove their posted content from the Football Remembers website by deleting their original post (e.g. from their Twitter or Instagram accounts).

If a photo has been tweeted without the authorisation of the person in the photo, it can be requested to be removed. Anyone can request for inappropriate or unauthorised photo content to be removed by emailing Jamie.reid@thefa.com. Children can make the request or the request can be made by their parent or carer.

How content is moderated

All tweets will be moderated prior to publication except those from the partners' platforms. The moderators have been DSB checked.

Acceptance of use

The Football Remembers website pulls images from social media identified by the hashtag #FootballRemembers and is a public space.

All partners will wish to use some selected photos (from those added to social media as part of this campaign) on their own digital channels to promote the online event, which would include using photos of those under 18 years of age.
