



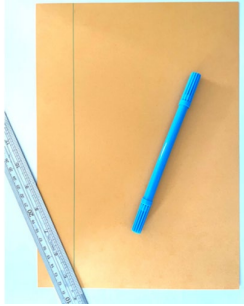

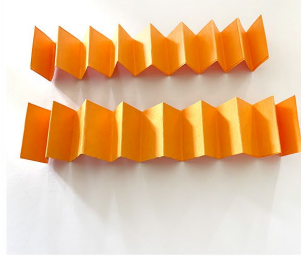
# Activity 1: Paper Rosettes

1



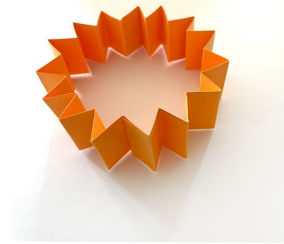
Draw x2 lines 3cm wide  
Cut two strips

2



Fold strips to create zig-zags

3



Join strips together  
at both end with glue/tape

4



Cut 1 circle and x3 ribbon  
strips & glue strips to bottom  
of circle

5



Cover the circle in glue

6



Place zig-zag circle on top  
of glue circle. Flatten using  
a cup or jar. Leave to dry

7



Draw a circle using  
something round as a  
template. Cut out.

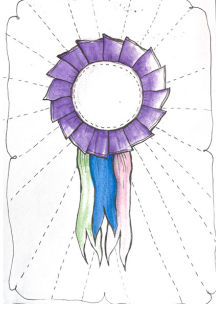

Glue top circle to the zig-zag circle and decorate

2



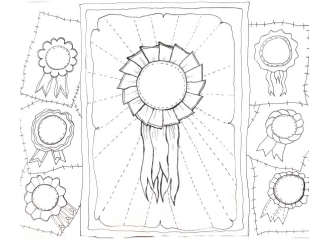
Add your own letters

Cut strips of coloured paper or card, perhaps in the colour of a national team.

*\*Snipped edging makes a great fringe effect!*

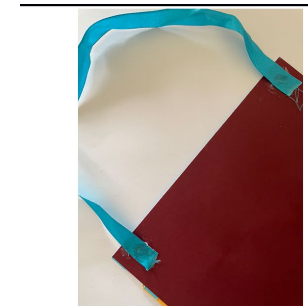
Arrange all of the design elements on a coloured background and glue in to place

4



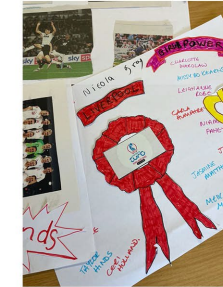
Attach a strip of ribbon or paper to the back of the banner so you can hang and display it!

## Library Celebration Display



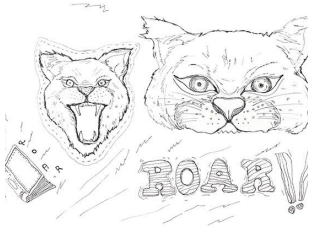
Create the display in a window or
