1.1.

Age

Players must be 16 years or older.

1.2.

Registration Process

Once you sign up through this form you will be sent a link to register on the Challengermode website.

All players must have a Challengermode Account with a FIFA Game Account connected to that account.

The player will create their profile with a suitable name. Once the player is ready, they may join the tournament but must confirm their participation (ready-up) before the player is completely registered.

Registrations will close on Wednesday 26 February.

1.3.

Player nationality

Each player must be eligible to represent England internationally and in possession of a valid passport containing a photograph and giving full particulars of their date of birth (day, month, year). Each player must have residency within the UK. The FA reserves the right to remove anyone who doesn't meet the criteria at any stage of the process.

1.4

If you qualify for the live event you must enter into a pre-agreement with The FA which will become active if you win the Beat the eLions tournament.

1.5

Participation stipulations

Entry into any Challengermode tournament means that you must comply with all of the rules outset within this document.

Usernames/Team names
