

About the England Supporters Travel Club



The England Supporters Travel Club scheme entitles members to access to both home and away England match tickets, whereas the free England Supporters Club members is for home matches only.

The Travel Club membership is £75 for adults and £30 for juniors. The 2018-2020 membership period started on the 15 July 2018 and runs until 13 July 2020 so unlike traditional football club memberships, Travel Club members receive two years' worth of benefits.

Membership pack

We are pleased to announce that for the 2018-2020 membership we have reintroduced the membership packs. Now, when you renew or upgrade to the Travel Club you'll receive a limited edition membership pack containing England branded merchandise and your personalised card. Membership packs will begin to get dispatched from the end of August/early September providing security checks have been completed.

Home matches

Unlike the England Supporters Club membership, Travel Club members receive £5 off their England home match ticket (£2.50 juniors) as standard. For selected matches, a greater discount will be offered. For the 2016-2018 membership period, Travel Club members benefitted from over £150 in discounts when buying tickets during the priority sales. As a Travel Club member, you can purchase up to 8 tickets for England home games.

Tickets for England home games are typically dispatched 2-3 weeks prior to kick-off. If you elect to receive your tickets electronically, these are usually sent the week of the match via email for you to print off at home or save to an Apple device. Supporters are advised that tickets can arrive up to two days before a match takes place, but if for whatever reason they do not receive their tickets, replacements can be collected from the West Box Office on matchday.

Away matches

The England Supporters Travel Club is the only way to obtain tickets in the official England 'end' at away matches. By signing up to the Travel Club now, you can combine visiting other countries whilst following the Three Lions abroad.

The ticket policy for England away matches (including tournaments) is strictly one per Travel Club member. However, members can purchase up to up to four tickets in an order by assigning other Travel Club fan numbers to each ticket. In order to apply for away match tickets, Travel Club members will need to register their interest in a ticket via the "Tickets and Matches" page.

Once your registration is confirmed and the ticket allocation is known we may then need to run a ballot to allocate tickets; for more information on ballots please refer to our 'membership rules'.

Important: it is against membership rules to sell, offer to sell or pass on England match tickets. This includes advertising a ticket sale via any form of website or social media and via the ESTC forum. Any Travel Club member, who sells, offers to sell or passes on their match ticket will have that ticket cancelled and their ESTC membership suspended.

Tickets for England away games must be collected by each individual from the host city. Collection details are sent to all ticket holders before an away game but in order to collect your ticket, you will need to bring a form of photo ID with you. No tickets will be posted out for away friendlies or qualifiers.

Euro 2020

Members of the free England Supporters Club are advised that if they wish to attend England matches at Euro 2020 (subject to qualification) they will need to upgrade to the England Supporters Travel Club before applications open in December 2019.

The ticket policy for tournament fixtures is one per Travel Club member, so if you wish to attend as a group, all potential ticket holders need to be members of the Travel Club in order to be eligible to apply.

In the event that demand exceeds supply of tickets during the application process, a ballot will be undertaken based on members' caps. It is therefore the responsibility of the member to ensure they check their caps level after attending each England game to ensure that they do not potentially miss out on tournament tickets.

We anticipate applications for Euro 2020 to begin in December 2019 (subject to England's qualification).

Caps

Travel Club members earn two caps for attending England home and away games (excluding tournament fixtures). The caps system is in place to ensure that tickets to oversubscribed England away games and tournament fixtures are distributed as fairly as possible.

If a match is oversubscribed (there is more demand than available tickets) then 70% of tickets will be awarded to fans (who registered) at the top of the caps table with the rest of the tickets going to a ballot. By building up your caps level now from attending England friendlies and qualifiers, you will have a better chance of being allocated tickets for away matches and tournaments.

Caps are only awarded after attending England men's senior qualifiers and friendlies – not when the tickets are purchased. Caps are non-transferable and cannot be retrospectively applied more than 21 days after an England match has taken place or if you attended prior to becoming a member of the England Supporters Club or Travel Club. It is not possible to transfer caps from one member to another.

Please note: The caps system runs on a maximum four year rolling basis so any caps earned prior to Euro 2016 will now be inactive and show on your 'all-time' caps total.

Security

By applying to become a member of the England Supporters Travel Club, all applicants will undergo a background security check. This check is to help ensure the safety and security of those attending England games and to help protect the reputation of England fans abroad.
