SOUTH ASIANS: FOOTBALL PARTICIPATION (16+)

ADULT PARTICIPATION TARGETS





Within grassroots football, male and female South Asian participation (aged 16+) shows to be at a healthy rate. Male participation is at a record **11.1%** (up from 7.4% in 2023). **6.5%** of these players are playing affiliated football.

Female representation is currently at **15.4%** (up from 13.6% in 2023). However, **17.3%** of all females in affiliated football are South Asian females indicating a healthy representation of SA females in the game.

The numbers are promising and shows that South Asian communities remain invested and interested in the game.

Please note: We are now collecting and categorising participation by 'South Asian' representation for the first time. This refers to people self disclosing as **Indian, British Indian, Pakistani, British Bangladeshi only.**



Playing affiliated football is the best way for South Asian youth players to enter official playing pathways and progress to the professional game [pro football sees a major underrepresentation of South Asian players].

Within youth grassroots football, male and female South Asian participation (aged 5-15) shows to be at a healthy rate. Male participation is at a record **8%** (up from 6.9% in 2023) with **5%** of males playing affiliated football. Female representation is currently at **7.4%** (up from 6.7% in 2023) with **4.6%** of South Asian females playing affiliated football. Both Male and Female youth football continues to grow within South Asian communities.


